



## 503-029 Worldwide Industrial (Off-Highway)

This warranty applies to new engines that are used in industrial (off-highway) applications. Separate warranty coverage is provided for QSK95 T4 locomotive, marine, generator drive and certain defense applications.

### Coverage

The **warranty start date** is the date of delivery of the engine to the first retail purchaser, or the first use of the engine in a leased, rented or loaned unit, or when the engine has operated 50 hours, whichever of the three occurs first.

## Limitations

---

- **During the Base Engine Warranty, Cummins allows travel** from the nearest authorized repair location to the job site to repair a warrantable failure.
- **The Extended Major Components Warranty ONLY covers** failed major components and progressively damaged major components.
- **Owner is responsible** for the cost of all parts required for the repair **except for the defective Covered Part and any Covered Part damaged by a Warrantable Failure of the defective Covered Part.**
- **Failures of belt(s) and hoses** supplied by Cummins are not covered beyond the first 500 hours or one year of operation, whichever occurs first.
- **Starters and alternators** are covered under this warranty.
- **For all A Series applications, including industrial,** travel reimbursement for non-transportable equipment will be limited to 4.0 hours, \$0.25/mile and 250 miles maximum. Any costs beyond this limit are the customer's responsibility.
